Commissioner Ward #1 Resignation and Upcoming Election

ENNIS, TX – Today, Commissioner Rowdy Pruitt resigned from the Ennis City Commission, effective immediately. Earlier this morning, Commissioner Pruitt filed a letter of resignation with the City Secretary’s Office citing increased demands on his business and family obligations. After careful consideration, he has decided that stepping down from his position as a City Commissioner is in the best interest of his constituents.

Elected in May of 2016, Commissioner Pruitt has been an advocate for the progress of our community representing the citizens of Ward #1. On behalf of the City Commission, I wish Commissioner Pruitt continued success in all his future endeavors.

In accordance with the City of Ennis Home Rule Charter, the process to fill the vacant commission seat will commence promptly. We will ensure a smooth transition to maintain continuity in governance and to uphold the trust of our citizens.

An election will be ordered to fill the vacancy for Ennis City Commissioner, Ward #1. Details regarding the election date and candidate filing process will be announced shortly.
